

**MOREE GOLF CLUB**  
**2024 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**  
**PRESIDENTS REPORT**

It is with pleasure that I present this report to the Moree Golf Club membership.

The Golf Club continues to perform well financially and it is my expectation that this will continue into the future.

During the past year, Golf Club Committee has invested substantially into Course improvements under the direction of our General Manager Simon Payne and our Greens Superintendent, Schalk Van Greuen. The present state of our Course, and how it has been improved during the past twelve months, is testimony to their efforts and I wish to acknowledge and congratulate them on their efforts.

I wish to also acknowledge and congratulate our resident Golf Professional, Darren Burger on his commitment to the Club and his significant investment to encourage the Junior Golf in the town and district.

There has also been significant investment in machinery to a point where we no longer have to rely on third party contractors for periodic green and tee restorations and other improvements to the playing surface.

The Course Watering System is all but complete with the Bore coming on line and plumbing completed to the fourth tank. I also wish to acknowledge the inputs from members of the Greens Committee as we have been able to increase the Bore licence capacity from 50 megalitres to 200 megalitres, further ensuring a reliable, clean water supply to the Course.

The Legends of Golf Pro-Am tournament was again an outstanding success, as was the Moree Veterans Week of Golf, and I congratulate those involved. Both these events are scheduled again in the year.

The deck extensions to the southern side of the Club House will commence in mid-January with anticipated completion by the end of March. There will of course be some disruptions during this time, however with most of the steel framework being fabricated off site, these disruptions should be kept to a minimum.

There have been further investments to the Golf Club furniture and there is an ongoing, and timely replacement program in place for this to be ongoing as the need arises.

Going forward, the Motel Project, or similar development, is still very much on the agenda and I would expect this to gain momentum once the Deck extensions are completed.

In closing, I wish to thank the other Board members for their ongoing commitment to the Club and the Golf Club staff for their ongoing efforts to ensure Moree Golf Club remains the premier venue not only in the North west but rural New South Wales.
